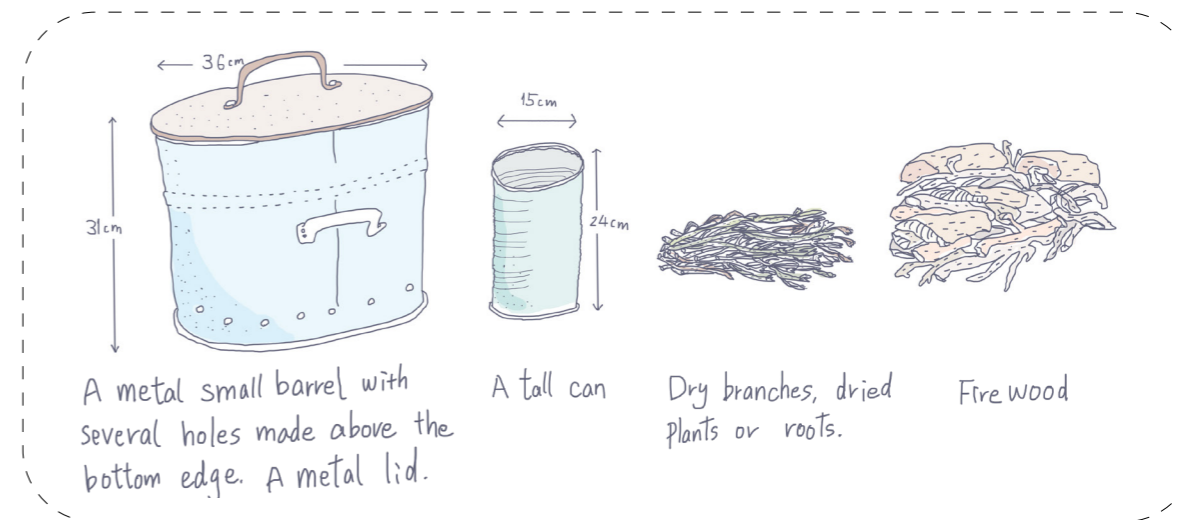


Hands-on approach to your own biochar!

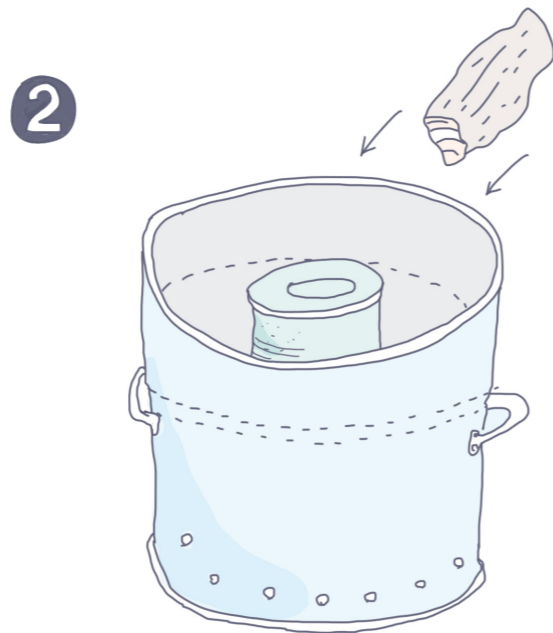
- Metal small barrel version

1 Insert the carbon materials into the tall can. The carbon materials can be dry branches, dry plants, roots or rice husks for example. Push them tightly into the can.



2 Place it top down in the barrel.



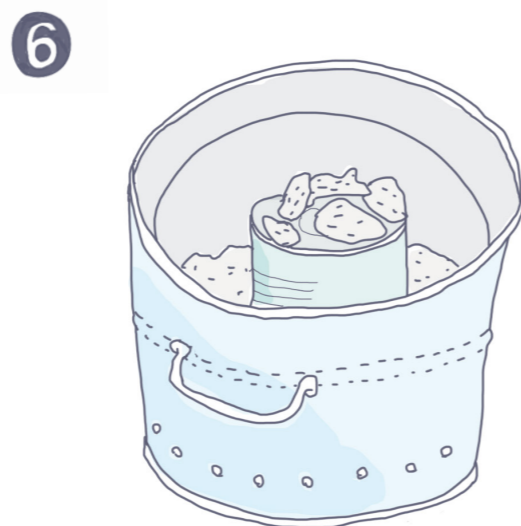
3 Fill it completely with the fire wood.



4 Start the fire from the top. The carbonizing process has started in the can!



5 Once the fire gets going, you can cook meals, even eggs - sunny side up, miso soup, gluhwein. Bon appetit!



6 Wait until the can has cooled down.



7 Pour the biochar slowly and store it for use.
